

Sorting at source begins in the kitchen

This is where you must begin separating the glass, plastic and metal from the material, which can be digested/composted.

From the garden:

Grass clippings, leaves, twigs, weeds, bark, small branches, hedge cuttings and sawdust. Remember to save some garden waste during the summer for use in the Green Johanna in the winter.

Remember

Try to recycle as much waste as possible and in particular use a Green Cone or a Green Johanna for your food waste. If you simply put food waste into your bin it will probably be taken to a landfill site where, as it breaks down, it will produce methane gas.

The Green Cone

Patented design ensures the almost total breakdown of all food waste into its natural components of water and carbon dioxide, thus producing minimal residue. The double-walled solar cone creates a heat trap of circulating air to encourage the growth of harmless bacteria and also helps to insulate the waste in winter. With the digestion chamber below ground level there are no smells and the worms and natural soil organisms can migrate freely in and out of the basket.

Height (above ground) 70cm; Depth (below ground) 42cm; Diameter of lid 28cm; Diameter (top of basket) 59cm

The Green Johanna

The Green Johanna is not a simple traditional composter. Through innovative design it can safely handle both garden and all food waste, producing an excellent quality compost. The unit has a rodent proof base plate and the compost is easily accessed through two sliding doors. The Green Johanna ideally composts two parts of food waste to one part of garden waste and can be supplied with a winter jacket to improve its performance in very cold weather.
